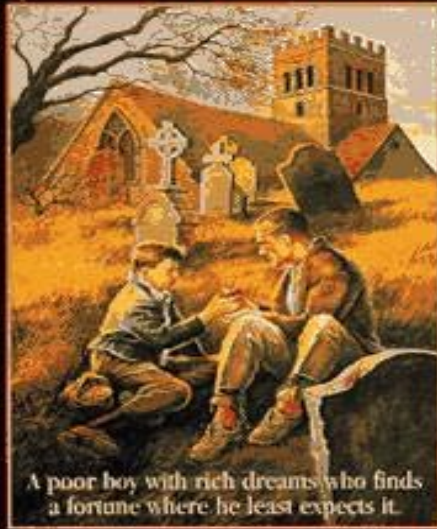

- ❖ Appears in the morning everyday except the seventh day- the Sabbath (16:4)
- ❖ Everyone has equal share (16: 16-18, 21)
- ❖ Only last one day (16:19-20)
- ❖ On sixth day collect double portion (Sabbath is a day of rest) (16: 5, 22)
- ❖ Manna teaches the lesson of living one day at a time
